President, Ms. Christy Nichols, called the second Business Session of the 65th Annual Meeting of the South Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists to order at 12:50pm.

The President introduced the head table.

Mr. Skip Chappell gave the invocation.

Lunch was served.

The President recognized Chief Sergeant-at-Arms, Lee Balentine for a report. Mr. Balentine reported that there are 45 members registered and 41 voting members present. A quorum was established.

Vice President Dana Long introduced Christy Nichols so that she may address the assembly.

Ms. Nichols gave her Presidential Farewell Address

President Nichols opened the floor for any unfinished business that should come before the assembly. With no unfinished business presented the floor was closed to unfinished business.

President Nichols opened the floor for new business and directed the members attention to the first item on the agenda under new business related to the proposed budget for 2012-2013. The report distributed during the first business session had several errors 1) there is a line item on the credit report (Miscellaneous \$50.00) that is missing on the debit report. 2) also the dates on the Debit and Credit reports should reflect July 1, 2012 – June 30, 2013 (they are currently mismatched) and 3) the Year-to-Date report is not accurately represented.

The Chair recognizes John Bowen Chairman of the SCSRT Board of Directors to give his report. Mr. Bowen recommends the adoption of the changes to the 2012-2013 Proposed Budget. No second is required for this motion.

President Nichols opens the floor for discussion pertaining to the 2012-2013 Proposed Budget. There being no further discussion - all those in favor of adopting the 2012-2013 Proposed Budgets raise your hand, those opposed raise your hand. The budget is adopted without opposition.

President Nichols announced that a motion from the Board has been made to combine all three separate checking accounts into one checking account. The floor is opened for discussion – there being no discussion – all in favor of the decision to combine the checking accounts raise your hand, those opposed. The motion was passed without opposition.

President Nichols announced the next motion from the Board to combine both Certificates of Deposits upon maturity (March and June) into one. The floor is opened for discussion – there being no discussion – all in favor of the decision to combine the Certificates of Deposit raise your hand, those opposed. The motion was passed without opposition

The President recognized all Life, Charter, and Honorary Members, ASRT Fellows and Floyd L. Driver Award recipients and Past Presidents of the SCSRT.
