ELIGIBILITY:

Any registered technologist or senior student currently enrolled in an approved radiography program in South Carolina, who is a member of the SCSRT and is accepted into a program leading to advancement in a healthcare related field or a specialty or specialty area within the imaging sciences.

AWARD:

The selection of the recipient will be made based on the criteria listed below. The award will be given at the Annual Meeting and will be published in the July Image-Maker.

CRITERIA:

Candidate selections will be made on the basis of professional interest and aptitude, academic performance, both general and technical.

Technical academic performance

General academic performance. (Include an official transcript (seal of envelope must not be broken) from your College(s)/Program.)

Professional Attitude

Confidential appraisals

Three (3) confidential appraisals are required. One (1) should come from each of the following groups of individuals: Program Director/Instructor; Technologist/

Radiologist/Other; Clinical Instructor/Supervisor. Please have each of the above individuals

return his/her appraisal form to you in a sealed envelope.

Write a 300-500 word essay answering the following questions:

- A. What factors influenced your decision to continue your education?
- B. What are your long-term goals within your profession?
- C. What is the purpose of our professional organization?
- D. Why is it important to support your professional organization?

The above essay should be TYPED and DOUBLE SPACED on plain white paper. Each student will be critiqued for the following: Proper use of English grammar, punctuation and spelling, clarity of thoughts and realistic goals.

Community involvement/leadership. List any committees, clubs, activities or class offices you have held while in your Radiologic Technology Program/professional career.

A letter of acceptance into an advanced degree program in a healthcare related field or specialty area, stating the date when the program will begin.
