STAFF SCIENTIFIC PRESENTATION

Guidelines

I. AWARDS

1. First Place.....\$125.00 Award and \$50.00 and Taft Memorial Trophy
2. Second Place.....\$ 70.00 and Second Place Award
3. Third Place..... \$ 40.00 and Third Place Award

II. ELIGIBILITY

The eligibility for competition and awards is established as follows:

1. Applicant must be listed as a current active or associate member in SCSRT at time of application.
2. The President of SCSRT and the previous year winner of this category are ineligible.
3. Student members who cannot compete in the Student category due to previous certification.

III. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Completely fill out the printed form. Incomplete applications are invalid.
2. Applications must be sent by certified mail and postmarked by **(February 1)**. Late applications will not be accepted.
3. Applicant will receive acknowledgement of application from the Chair of the Scientific Survey Committee.
4. A biographical sketch for use by the moderator must accompany the application.

IV. SUBJECT MATTER

1. Selection of the topic is the choice of the applicant. Advice from others concerning content or visual aids, etc. is acceptable.
2. Presentation must have evidence of scientific research to include: data, statistics and references. Quotations must be attributed to their source.
3. The presentation must be the work of the presenter.
4. The subject of the presentation should be pertinent to radiologic technology and shall be supplemented by audiovisual aids.
5. The presentation should demonstrate originality, be of general interest and value to technologists from both practical and educational view points, and be presented in an organized fashion.

V. PRESENTATION

1. Each presentation shall be no longer than 10 minutes when presented. Judges will deduct one (1) point for every minute over 10 minutes. There is no penalty for less than 10 minutes.
2. Audiovisual aids shall be used to enhance the presentation.
3. The SCSRT shall provide a laptop, a LCD projector, a screen, and a laser pointer.

VI. JUDGING

1. All presentations will be presented at the SCSRT meeting on Thursday.
2. In case of a tie category D points will determine the placement of the presentation winners.
3. Decision of the judges is final.
4. Winners will be announced at the Awards Luncheon on Friday.
